

# PUBLIC NOTICE

**The Department of Public Works will be flushing hydrants  
Throughout the Village during the  
Week of JULY 30<sup>th</sup>**

The project is scheduled to be completed within 5-6 days. Flushing hydrants is a very important routine maintenance practice. It helps to “exercise” the hydrant valves and to maintain water lines in good working order. The Public Works Department also looks to identify any problems or needed repairs.

Please note that there is a change from previous years as the hydrant flushing will be conducted during the regular work day instead of overnight.

Residents may experience temporary discoloration of their water due to the flushing activity. This is not harmful in any way. Simply run your water by opening multiple faucets throughout your home or flushing toilets until the water color clears. If your water coloration does not return to normal after several minutes of flushing, please contact Village Hall at (262) 783-2525.
