

Sec. 2-4-7 Community Development Authority.

- (a) The Village President shall appoint seven (7) resident persons as commissioners of the Community Development Authority, which appointments shall have the qualifications listed herein and shall be subject to confirmation by the Village Board. Two (2) of said commissioners shall be members of the Village Board and shall serve on the Authority during their respective terms of office as Board members. The initial appointments of the five (5) non-Board commissioners shall be for the following terms: two (2) commissioners for one (1) year, and one (1) commissioner each for a respective term of two (2), three (3) and four (4) years. Thereafter, the terms of the non-Board commissioners shall be four (4) years until their successors are appointed and qualified.
- (b) Except for the two (2) commissioners who are members of the Village Board, the commissioners shall have qualifications consisting of ability and experience in the fields of community development, financing, accounting, and community planning and shall particularly have experience in the creation of jobs and tax base through commercial and light industrial development.
- (c) The Community Development Authority shall have those powers and duties prescribed in Title 13, Chapter 2 of this Code of Ordinances.
