- B) Motion by Thew; second by Benjamin to approve Resolution 17-02; a Resolution to reduce the number of election Officials for the February 21, 2017 Spring Primary Election. Motion carried unanimously.
- C) Motion by Benjamin; second by Kasdorf to approve Resolution 17-03; an Initial Resolution Authorizing General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$480,000 for Street Improvement Projects. Motion carried unanimously.
- D) Motion by Benjamin; second by Orvis to approve Resolution 17-04; an Initial Resolution Authorizing General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$550,000 for Water system Projects. Motion carried unanimously.
- E) Motion by Benjamin; second by Van Gompel to approve Resolution 17-05; a Resolution providing for the sale of not to exceed \$1,030,000 General Obligation Corporate Purpose Bonds, Series 2017A. Motion carried unanimously.
- F) Public Hearing on Request for a Conditional Use Permit for R. James Blair for small engine repair and assembly shop at 12506 W. Hampton Ave., pursuant to Title 13, Chapter 1, Article D, Section 13-1-75 SubSection (e) of the Village of Butler Code of Ordinances. The property is Zoned B-1 Community Business District.

- H) Public Hearing on Certified Survey Map No. 9586 for the Division of Parcel 1 of Certified Survey Map No. 9586 being a part of the Northeast  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the Southwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  and the Northwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the Southeast  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 36, Township 8 North, Range 20 East, in the Village of Butler, Waukesha County, Wisconsin to divide this parcel into two (2) Lots. The property is Zoned R-1 Single Family Residential District.


Motion by Thew; second by Van Gompel to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 7:27 PM.
