

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
## Notes of Interest

- The Village of Butler celebrated the retirement of Officer Rick Napierala after 29 years of service.
  - Officer Boyle returned to full duty.
  - Officer Ratzlaff transitions to working day shift and Officer Knapp replaced Officer Ratzlaff on late shift.
  - The hiring process was completed and William Eisenhardt was selected as our next officer. His starting date will be January 10, 2018.








