My name is Alex Tomter and I am the head baseball coach at Bryant & Stratton College. I have known of and played on the lower field at Frontier Park so many times in my baseball career, it really is a great place when taken care of! I live nearby and decided to take my dog for a walk at Frontier to check out how the old ballfield was doing and noticed that it is in rough shape and probably hasn't been played on since the Butler Dunns folded operations.

At Bryant & Stratton we are currently under contract with Trenary Field to use their field for games for two more years. However, we are often very short on a place to practice because we take a back seat to Menomonee Falls High School teams. I am interested in using the field at Frontier and would totally fix them up myself if that is what it takes. In the future once our deal in the Falls runs out, I would also be interested in possibly making this park our home field.

I am not going to have any sort of funding for renting it out for these first couple of years as that has been budgeted to Menomonee Falls and Trenary, but if we could talk about a deal involving me fixing up these fields I am quite sure I could get you guys some business from local select teams, tournaments, camps and much more. When it comes time for us to talk about moving on from Trenary, Frontier Park would be at the top of my list.

I'd love to talk to somebody about this and see what your thoughts are.
